The May 8th meeting will be hosted by Professor Larry Lichten of UCLA's Manufacturing Engineering Program. He will give a brief slide presentation explaining the basics of CAD/CAM (computer aided design and manufacturing) and also discuss UCLA's Manufacturing Engineering Program. This will be followed by a tour of UCLA's Computer Aided Design Lab, one of the largest in the nation. It currently contains Lockheed's CADAM system, IBM's GDP Research Solid Modeling System, and Prime Computer's Medusa System.

The meeting will be held at Franz Hall, room 1178, UCLA (Wilshire offramp of the 405 freeway). There will be a \$2 fee for parking. Use the lot at the southwest corner of Hilgard and Westholme. The social hour will begin at 6:30pm and the meeting/presentation at 7:30pm. 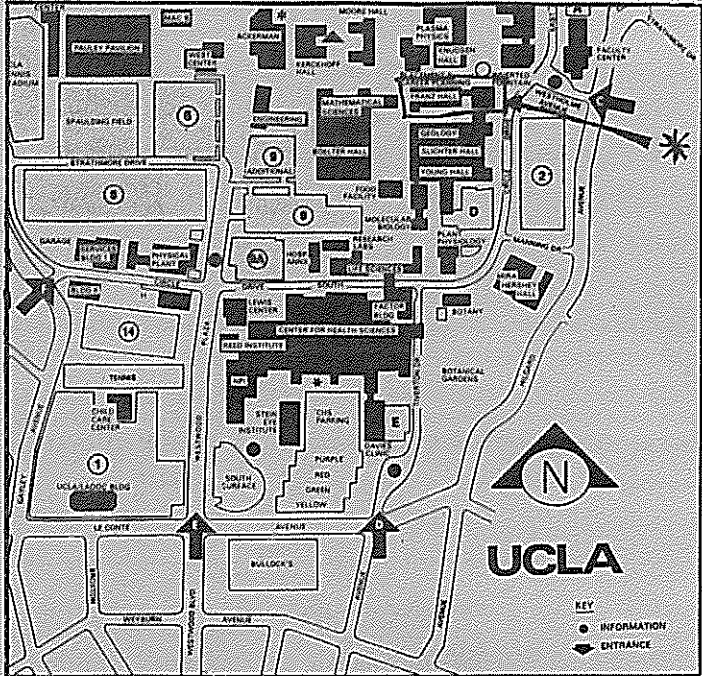
